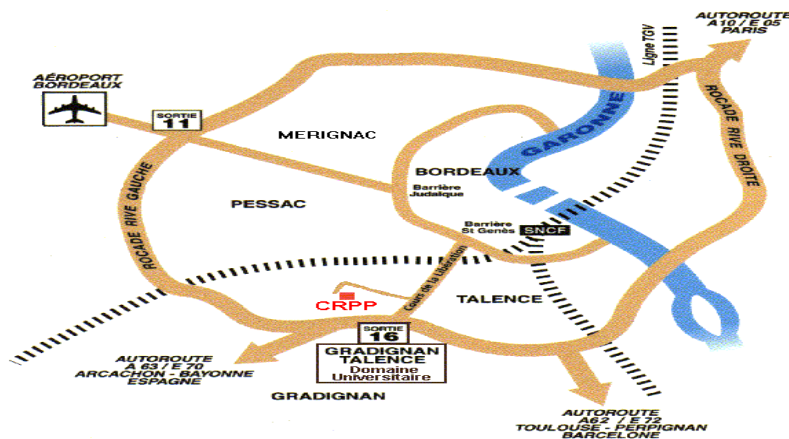

Practical Information

How to get to Bordeaux

By car

If you are coming to Bordeaux by car there are three highways that will take you there, the A63 and A62 that come from Spain, and the A10 that comes from Paris. These highways will lead you to Bordeaux's highway A630 that surrounds the city and where you can find all the main entrances to Bordeaux.



By plane

Currently there are direct flights to Bordeaux from several French and European cities like Paris, Lyon, London, Madrid, Lisbon or Amsterdam. At early 2010 a new low cost terminal started and there are flights from Bordeaux to Porto, Edinburgh, Bologna, Liverpool, Bristol and Milan. There is a shuttle bus service from airport to Bordeaux downtown at St Jean train station ("Gare Saint Jean").



How to get to Ice-Breaker event

Wednesday February 29th, 18-19:30

Venue: Hotel Mercure Bordeaux St-Jean, 28-30 rue Tauzia, 33800 BORDEAUX



The hotel is located about 300 meters from the train station Bordeaux Gare St-Jean.
Public transport: tramway line C, stop Tauzia, or bus line 16/17, stop Peyronnet

Coming by car:

From Paris on the A10, take exit 1 and follow signs for Bordeaux. Follow the bypass [Rocade] and take exit 21 for Bordeaux Centre. Take the A631, carry straight on and then take the slip road on the left into Rue Peyronnet. Turn right into Rue des Beaux Arts. Turn back on yourself into Rue Tauzia. From Toulouse, follow signs for Bègles/Bordeaux/Libourne and then continue toward Bordeaux Centre.

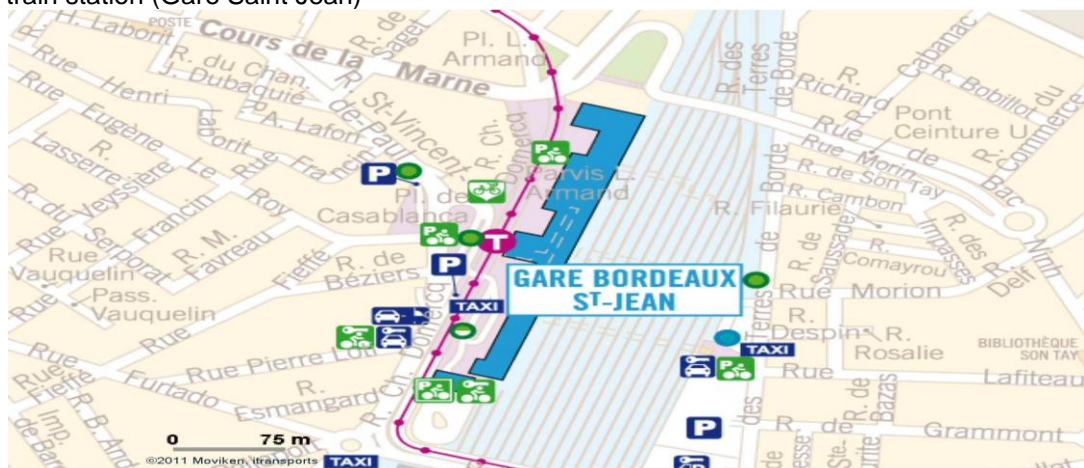
