This collaboration has already allowed some collaborative publications in international journals.

- Cooperation with the University of Gent has been developed through the scientific collaboration with Belgian colleagues as well as the interchange of students between both Universities. Students will be exchanged to perform their MSc thesis under the subjects of gaseous losses by N₂O emission and potential denitrification from soils amended with different organic residues from different sources.

- Collaboration with Czech University of Life Sciences (Faculty of Agrobiolgy - Prague) will be carried out on the scope of the effect of fermented pig slurry fertilization on the quality of vegetables.

- Collaboration with Universidade Federal de Santa Catarina, Universidade Federal de Pernambuco e Universidade Federal do Rio de Janeiro has been developed through the scientific collaboration with Brazilian colleagues as well as the interchange of students between both Universities. Students will be exchanged to perform their MSc thesis under the subjects of forced evaporation of landfill lechate enhanced with biogas production/recovery as a way to reduce the effects of the greenhouse gases emission.
